● Oil Pollution

● Bunker Operations:

- ◆ Are deck scuppers positively plugged before start of operations?
- ◆ Are transfer procedures established and being adhered to by sea staff in charge of the operations?
- ◆ Have communications been established with shore personnel and loading procedures agreed?
- ◆ Is oil spill dispersant readily available to fight oil spills?
- ◆ Is a portable transfer pump readily available or other means on aft part of the vessel to fight oil spills together with oil pollution absorbent pads?
- ◆ Have emergency stops for pumps been tested?

● Loading/Discharging Cargo Operations:

- ◆ Are deck scuppers positively plugged before start of cargo operations?
- ◆ Are transfer procedures established and fully understood by sea staff in charge of the cargo operations?
- ◆ Have communications been established with shore terminal and loading/discharging procedures/sequences agreed?
- ◆ Is oil spill dispersant readily available to fight oil spills?
- ◆ Is a portable transfer pump readily available on aft part of the vessel to fight oil spills, together with oil pollution absorbent pads?
- ◆ Have sea valves been examined and correctly set?
- ◆ Have emergency stops for pumps been tested?

● Prevention Of Pollution By Garbage And Waste

- ◆ Is your incinerator in working condition?
- ◆ Are you disposing of the garbage according to the pollution regulations, MARPOL 83, Annex V?
- ◆ Is your sewage plant in working condition?

● Air Pollution

- ◆ Are you reporting to engine staff about emission of black smoke from the vessel's funnel?
