

ONBOARD CREW MANAGEMENT

JOB TITLE/RANK	Pump Man
DEPARTMENT	Deck
RESPONSIBLE TO	Chief Officer

It is recognized that certain nationalities of crews are accustomed to different duties compared to other nationalities (For example officers responsible for the maintenance of safety and lifesaving equipment). Accordingly, the Master has the authority to change the tasks as he sees fit in agreement with the Ship Management Office.

In addition, the Master has the authority to allocate any reasonable task or duties that may be required for the safe and efficient operation of the ship.

MAIN PURPOSE OF THE JOB:

Assisting in the planning and execution of all cargo related operations such as loading, discharging, tank cleaning, inerting, gas freeing, etc. Performing cargo related duties as required for vessel type and trade.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Pump-man is responsible to the Chief Officer for:

- Assisting the Duty Officer/surveyor with temperature/ullage readings and cargo sampling as ordered by the Chief Officer
- Efficient execution of loading/discharging operations in co-operation with the Duty Officer
- Inspecting, maintaining and cleaning the pump-room
- Ensuring that all valves, pipes, and tanks, etc, are properly marked for easy identification
- Changing of reducers, packing and flanges as necessary and in accordance with the Chief Officers instructions
- Keeping all tools, equipment, pump-man store, etc. in good order and obtaining stock as requested by the Chief Officer
- Complying with the lubrication schedule for all cargo equipment and deck machinery as applicable.

PERSONAL BEHAVIOURS & QUALITIES

The job requires:

- Good team working skills
- Ability to perform all tasks in an orderly way
- Comfortable understanding and following instruction and willing to ask for clarification if necessary
