- Subject:** Provisions for conditions of cadets on board Panamanian flag vessels.

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1. Purpose

- 1.1.** The purpose of this Circular is to communicate to the users of the Panamanian Registry, the provisions for conditions to be provided by the ship-owner to cadets on board of Panamanian flag vessels.

2. Scope

- 2.1.** This Merchant Marine Circular applies to all ship-owners, operators, and companies, maritime training centers and cadets.

- 3.** The provisions establish the minimum requirements that must be contained in the training agreement between the ship-owner, the cadet and/or maritime training center.
