SEEMP Part III Submissions

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Merchant Marine Notice is to remind all vessels owners/operators and local interested parties that in order to comply with Regulation 26 of Annex VI of MARPOL Convention as amended, must submit it's SEEMP Part III in a timely manner.

2. Definitions

The Ship Energy Efficiency Management Plan (SEEMP) Part III is a Ship Operational Carbon Intensity Plan and it must include as a minimum:

- a description of the methodology that will be used to calculate the ship's attained annual operational Carbon Intensity Indicator (CII).
- The processes that will be used to report this value to the ship's Administration.
- The required annual operational CII for the next three years.
- An implementation plan documenting how the required annual operational CII will be achieved during the next three years; and
- a procedure for self-evaluation and improvement.

3. Application

As of January 1, 2023, ships of 5,000 GT and above must have a verified ship energy efficiency management plan or SEEMP part III and the evidence of reduction in carbon intensity must be registered in a new section of the Management System of Carbon Intensity (SEEMP) existing of the ship.

Once you have the SEEMP part III on board, need to start executing the articulated plan, including the implementation of some or all the energy efficiency measures, if required.

Therefore, this Administration urge to the whole Panamanian fleet to contact its Recognized Organization to carry out said verification of the SEEMP part III.
