ROUTEING MEASURES OTHER THAN TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEMES – DANISH WATERS

No: **MMN-19/2021**

1. The purpose of this Merchant Marine Notice is to communicate to Masters, Ship-owners/Operators, Legal Representative of Panamanian Flag Vessels; Panamanian Merchant Marine Recognized Organizations (ROs), regarding the routeing measures other than traffic separation schemes in Danish waters.
 2. This administration is aware by the Danish Maritime Authority (DMA), the lack of compliance of some Panamanian flag vessels, with the International Maritime Organization (IMO) recommendations; provide within the OMI circular [SN.1/Circ.263](#) of October 23, 2007 - Routeing Measures other than Traffic Separation Schemes.
 3. This administration recommends to all the Masters, Ship-owners/Operators, Legal Representative of Panamanian Flag Vessels; Panamanian Merchant Marine Recognized Organizations (ROs) taking all the considerations described in the following items of the IMO circular SN.1/Circ.263, to avoid inconveniences with the navigation through these areas.
 - paragraph 1.9, amendments to the Recommendations on navigation through the entrances to the Baltic Sea;
 - paragraph 1.14, amendments to the deep-water route “North-east of Gedser”.
 4. According to Directive 2009/16/EC on Port State Control, ships which have not complied with the applicable version of the IMO Recommendation on navigation through the entrances to the Baltic Sea may be subject to additional Port State Control inspections, regardless of the period since the last periodic inspection.
 5. This Administration highly recommends Masters, Ship-owners /Operators, Legal Representative of Panamanian Flag Vessel; Panama Merchant Marine Recognized Organizations (ROs), to take note and review the IMO circular SN.1/Circ.263 - Routeing Measures other than Traffic Separation Schemes to avoid any misunderstood during the vessel navigating through the entrances to the Baltic Sea.
